

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The City of Clare will receive sealed bids for **Install Runway 4-22 & Taxiway A Lighting, at Clare Municipal Airport, Clare, Michigan, until 2:00 pm (local time) May 10th, 2019**. Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately following the time stated above.

All bidders must be MDOT prequalified. The classification required for the prime contractor on this project is L. There is sub-classification requirement of I.

There is a two (2) percent DBE requirement for this project.

Bids shall be addressed to the **Mead & Hunt, 2605 Port Lansing Rd, Lansing, Michigan 48906, Attn: Jeff Thoman**. Bids shall be sealed and shall have the name and address of the bidder clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. The envelope shall also be marked with the following: **Install Runway 4-22 & Taxiway A Lighting, Clare Municipal Airport, Clare, Michigan**. Bids must be submitted on the bid forms (provided in the proposal).

Bidders will submit a proposal guaranty in the form of a proposal bond, certified check, cashier's check or bank money order in the amount of not less than five (5) percent of the bid sum. The proposal guaranty shall be made payable to the City of Clare. If the selected contractor fails to provide the required materials and/or execute the contract within fifteen (15) days after being furnished with the necessary contract and bond forms, the proposal guaranty will be forfeited to the Sponsor (in accordance with Section 30-13 of the General Provisions). The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory 100 percent performance bond as well as labor and material bond.

No bid may be withdrawn after closing time for the receipt of proposals for a period of One Hundred Twenty (120) calendar days.

The City of Clare reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the bids or bid, should it consider same to be in its best interest.

A pre-bid meeting is scheduled for Friday, April 26, 2019, at 11am, at the Terminal Building, Clare Municipal Airport, Clare, MI 48617. The contractor is responsible for visiting the airport in order to assess the job site. Site visits can be arranged by contacting Mr. Gary Todd, at 989-802-2005.

Scope of Work

The Base Bid project consists of the installation of new Medium Intensity Runway based mounted Lights (MIRLs), new Medium Intensity Taxiway base mounted Lights (MITLs), and the replacement of a Constant Current Regulator (CCR). The base bid project shall be complete and ready for final inspection within 30 calendar days from the effective date of Notice-to-Proceed.

Bid Option 1 includes the installation of additional MITLs and an additional Guidance Sign along Taxiway A1. Bid Option 1 will add an additional 10 calendar days of allowable time.

Bid Option 2 includes the installation of two sets of Runway End Identifier Lights (REIL) and installation of a new Primary Wind Cone. Bid Option 2 will add an additional 2 calendar days of allowable time.
