RE: Approval to Purchase FLYGT Pump – WWTP Lift Station #3

For the Agenda of April 16, 2018

Background. As reflected in the attached Resolution 2015-035 (*copy att'd*), the City purchased its first FLYGT pump three years ago due to the manufacturer's claim that the pump did not clog under normal or adverse conditions. Since then, we've purchased two additional pumps as we've found the reliability claims of the manufacturer have proven to be accurate. Dale Clark, our Water & Wastewater Superintendent, has requested authority to purchase an additional FLYGT pump (*see copy of att'd memo & price quote*). The City Commission is asked to approve the request.

Issues & Questions Specified. Should the City Commission approve the request to purchase a FLYGT lift station pump?

Alternatives.

1. Approve the purchase request.
2. Disapprove the request.
3. Set aside decision regarding this matter to a later date.

Financial Impact. As reflected on the attached quotation, the cost of a new FLYGT pump is \$8,206. Note that the purchase price has only increased \$83 since 2015 when we purchased our first pump. Kennedy Industries remains the regional sole source provider for this pump; consequently, this is a sole source purchase. Dale's memo reflects that this is a budgeted item in his approved FY17/18 CIP, and funds are available to make the purchase.

Recommendation. I recommend that the City Commission approve Dale's request to purchase another FLYGT pump by adoption of Resolution 2018-041 (*copy att'd*).

RESOLUTION 2015-035

A RESOLUTION OF THE CLARE CITY COMMISSION APPROVING THE SOLE SOURCE ACQUISITION OF A FLYGT SUBMERSIBLE PUMP FROM KENNEDY INDUSTRIES.

WHEREAS, the City's wastewater crews spend an inordinate amount of time and energy dealing with clogged lift station pumps caused by items that are marketed as disposable (diapers, towels, etc.), but in reality are a tremendous resource drain on public service utilities; and .

WHEREAS, the City has attempted a very aggressive education campaign in an attempt to encourage its sanitary sewer customers to find alternative means to dispose of the "disposable" items other than flushing them into our system with no avail; and

WHEREAS, Kennedy Industries is marketing a new submersible pump that is claimed to be clog-free and offers a "no-clog" guarantee; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff has recommended the purchase of a single pump to determine the validity of said claim; and

WHEREAS, Kennedy Industries is presently the only known regional vendor for this particular pump, thus the City Staff has concurrently recommended authority for a sole-source ; acquisition of said pump; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed and considered said recommendations determined approval of a sole source acquisition of one pump is prudent and reasonable in light of the tremendous resources the City expends annually in un-clogging its existing submersible pumps.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Commission of the City of Clare hereby approves the sole-source acquisition of a Flygt Clog Free Submersible Pump for a cost not to exceed \$8,123.

ALL RESOLUTIONS AND PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS INSOFAR AS THEY CONFLICT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS RESOLUTION BE AND THE SAME ARE HEREBY RESCINDED.

WHEREAS, the City's Water & Wastewater Superintendent has requested authority to purchase an additional FLYGT pump as a spare to eliminate unnecessary down time in the event of unanticipated lift station pump failure; and

WHEREAS, the Clare City Manager has recommended approval of said request; and

WHEREAS, the Clare City Commission has reviewed and considered the recommendation of its staff and found it to be reasonable and prudent; and

WHEREAS, Kennedy Industries remains the regional sole source supplier of said lift station pump.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Clare, hereby approves the sole source purchase of a FLYGT lift station pump from Kennedy Industries for a purchase price of \$8,206.
