RE: Recognition – John Pedjac

For the Agenda of August 1, 2016

Background. Due to continuing budgetary challenges and constraints, the City was obliged to eliminate the full-time administrative position within the Clare Police Department. John Pedjac has served in this position for the past 13 years – 11 of which have been as a full-time employee of the City. Due to this personnel reduction within the Clare Police Department, John's employment with the City was terminated effective July 1, 2016. The City Commission is asked to formally recognize John for his dedicated service.

Issues & Questions Specified. Should the City Commission formally recognize John Pedjac for 13 years of service?

Alternatives.

1. Recognize John for his dedicated service.
2. Do not formally recognize John for his service.
3. Defer decision regarding the matter to a subsequently scheduled meeting.

Financial Impact. The cost to formally recognize John for his service is approximately \$12 for a frame for the resolution.

Recommendation. I recommend that the City Commission formally recognize John Pedjac for his service to the City of Clare and its residents by adoption of Resolution 2016-070 (*copy att'd*).

RESOLUTION 2016-070

A RESOLUTION OF THE CLARE CITY COMMISSION RECOGNIZING AND HONORING THE DEDICATED SERVICE OF JOHN PEDJAC.

WHEREAS, John Pedjac has faithfully served the City of Clare and its residents for the past 13 years as the administrative officer and dispatcher for the Clare Police Department – having served 11 of those years as a full-time employee of the City; and

WHEREAS, due to continuing budgetary challenges and shortfalls, the City made the difficult decision to eliminate the administrative position in the Clare Police Department resulting in the termination of John as an employee of the City of Clare; and

WHEREAS, the Clare City Commission deems it appropriate and imperative to formally recognize John’s distinct, honorable, dedicated, and devoted service to the residents and businesses of the City of Clare and to the Clare Police Department for the past 13 years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Clare, on behalf of the residents and business community of the Greater Clare Area Community, hereby formally recognizes John Pedjac for his exemplary tenure of service to the City of Clare and the Greater Clare Area Community for the past thirteen years as a City employee and concurrently recognizes John for his 21 years of voluntary service as a member of the Clare Police Department’s Police Officer Reserve unit, having served in that position with particular honor and distinction.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and Clare City Commission offers John its wishes for continued success in all endeavors and for good health and for prosperity.
