


Airport Manager Report

October 2016

1. Fuel sales remain strong and we continue on our record setting pace.



2. Private Pilot Ground School Class began the 13th of October. Currently there are 7 students enrolled in the class. The 10 week class will meet every Thursday evening from 6 to 9pm and be held at the Terminal Building. There are 10 students flying the training airplane with three different instructors.
3. The parallel taxi-way project slated for 2017 construction is on track. Design of the project has reached over 60% and a meeting was held to discuss any changes or additions last week. We anticipate final design being completed mid November. The project will be sent to bid in January and awarded in February. The project is scheduled to begin in August and take 60 days to complete it. I am anticipating only 10 days of runway closures during this construction phase.
4. We will participate in a large Poker Run being held Saturday, Oct 15th. Lakes of the North will host and organize the event with airplanes statewide flying to pre-determined airports. Once they arrive, they will receive a playing card. When all participants have visited all 5 airports, the entrant with the best poker hand will win a prize. I anticipate a spike in fuel sales that day and am looking forward to participating in this fun event in aviation.
