


Airport Manager Report

November 2016

1. Fuel sales remain strong and we continue on our record setting pace. I will receive another fuel tanker on the 18th of November. (8,500 gallons)



2. We are half way through the Fall Private Pilot Ground School Class. The 10 week class meets every Thursday evening from 6 to 9pm and be held at the Terminal Building.
3. The parallel taxi-way project slated for 2017 construction is on track. Design of the project has reached over 90% and a meeting was held to discuss any changes or additions last week. We anticipate final design being completed by the end of November. We will bid the project in January and be awarded in February. The project is scheduled to begin in August and take 60 days to complete it. I am anticipating only 10 days of runway closures during this construction phase.
4. DPW has completed the crack sealing of the runways and main ramp. Al purchased the product and as usual got the use of the kettle trailer to apply the product. There were many new cracks and some were quite wide. I appreciate the help from the DPW crew.
5. The Clare Municipal Airport was recently featured in a Morning Sun article. The title was, "Airport Fulfills Farwell Girl's Dream." A local Farwell girl, Abby Hurt, who has been blind since birth wanted to experience the feeling of flying.
