Have you ever seen eggs fall from the sky? Join Clare Parks and Recreation and the Clare Municipal Airport at our annual egg drop event!

The Easter Bunny will arrive by plane to the Clare Municipal Airport, and then pilots from the Clare Municipal Airport will be on hand to drop over 1,800 plastic eggs from an airplane! Youth ages 12 and under are able to retrieve the eggs and redeem them for candy. Before and after the event, local supporting organizations and volunteers will offer children's activities. Parents please dress your children warm and bring an Easter basket for them to collect their eggs in! If there is inclement weather, the planes will not be able to fly, however we will still have an egg "hunt" on the ground.

TIME: In an effort to accommodate the hundreds of people expected for this event, 3 drops will be planned, each according to age. The drop times are listed above. If you have children in multiple age groups, you are free to choose one drop for them to participate in. *Please note that parents must accompany small children on the field for the drops.*
