

CLARE STREET PROJECTS

Clare voters supported the November 2016 ballot proposal to improve our City streets. The support of this millage will allow us to vastly improve the condition of our streets over the next five- year period commencing in July 2017. The City will use the street improvement plan (copies available @ City Hall and on the City's website) presented in past newsletters as a guide in determining which streets will be improved each year for the next five years. We project approximately \$247,000 will be available in street millage funds in 2017. The funds generated by the voter-approved street millage will allow us to complete the following street projects this year:

- A complete reconstruction of the 200 Block of John R Street
- A complete reconstruction of the 100 Block of Beech Street
- A complete reconstruction of the 900 Block of Maple Street
- Mill & Fill (crush existing asphalt and repave) of the 100 Block of West 7th Street.

We will provide updates in future newsletters and on our website regarding anticipated construction start and completion dates for each of these projects and a financial accounting of the cost of each of these projects after they are completed each year.

Please note that in addition to the above 2017 road rehabilitation projects funded with the voter approved road improvement millage the City will also be reconstructing three blocks of Ann Arbor Trail with the assistance of a \$509,039 Michigan Economic Development Corporation Infrastructure Capacity Enhancement Grant.
